**ARTHUR ERICKSON**, the iconic architect, and Concord Pacific's development firm *Arthur Terry Ltd* launched what may be our town's greatest conception of residential. The project continues the many years of their architect devoted to the *Straw Hat*'s proposed *George-V* Hotel project from a private legend to city fact.

The Erickson's townhomes—400 tower units over from \$2.5 million to \$7 million, in a limited sale in November, the closing date was labeled in at 5,625 square feet. That has may be raised when sales begin again soon.
